

The process for applying for funding from Leukaemia & Lymphoma NI is as follows:

1. Applicants should complete the:
  - i. Grant Application Summary
  - ii. Breakdown of CostsAnd send these documents to [info@llni.co.uk](mailto:info@llni.co.uk)
2. The applications will be assessed and by the Scientific & Medical Committee who will either encourage or discourage a full application.
3. In addition to scientific and research quality applications must meet two essential criteria:
  - i. The proposed research must be related to work currently being undertaken by the Research Group.
  - ii. The proposed research must be located predominantly in Northern Ireland.

The Scientific and Medical Committee consider the following a desirable criterion:

- i. Applications which are focused on acquiring experimental data that could subsequently be used to leverage a major project grant application from a national body.
4. Applications that pass the triage process will be allocated to peer review and sent to reviewers who have recognised expertise in the topic of the proposal.
5. Highly rated applications will be tabled to the Leukaemia & Lymphoma NI Board of Directors who will make a final funding decision. Applicants may be invited to meet with the Board to discuss their funding request.

All applicants will be provided with feedback on their application.
